Coxswain FF1200 basic

Duration	4 days
Target group	Personnel who will perform coxswain duties on FF1200 and other lifeboats are built according to DNV 406 regulations.
Prerequisites	Basic Safety Training.
Objective	<p>The course aims to enable participants to execute a safe and effective evacuation using the FF 1200 lifeboat by building competence on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- prepare the lifeboat for evacuation- organize and lead muster and boarding- launch the lifeboat according to procedure- ensure passenger health and safety after evacuation- establish communication with rescue units.
Contents	<p>During the course, the following topics will be covered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Historical background- Regulations and requirements- Crew tasks and duties- Radio communication and procedures- The release arrangement- Emergency systems- The emergency response organisation- Alternative means of evacuation- Staying at sea, maneuvering the lifeboat- Helicopter pick-up- First aid in lifeboats- Crisis management and human reactions.
Exam	Written and practical exam. A certificate will be issued if the exams are passed.
