## Advanced Fire Fighting Team Member (ERT)

<b>Duration</b>	2 days
<b>Target group</b>	This program is designed to fulfill the training and assessment needs for persons who are members of an Offshore Fire/Emergency Response Team at an Offshore Installation which is susceptible to experiencing disastrous industrial fires.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	A valid BOSIET/TBOSIET or FOET/TFOET Certificate
<b>Objective</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Equip the delegate with the necessary knowledge, understanding and skills to perform the role of Emergency Response Team Member safely and effectively.</li> </ul>
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Delegates who successfully complete this course will acquire the following knowledge and skills:</p> <p>Theory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Knowledge of Offshore Fire/Emergency response arrangements</li> <li>•Preparing to enter the incident area</li> <li>•Gaining access to the incident area</li> <li>•Using best working practices and procedures</li> <li>•Locating missing personnel and casualty handling</li> <li>•On scene first aid procedures</li> <li>•Selecting and using the correct portable firefighting equipment including foam wheeled unit</li> <li>•Extinguishing live fires (fuel in-depth/troughs/pressure fires)</li> <li>•Conducting and controlling BA operations</li> <li>•Maintaining communications</li> </ul> <p>Practical</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Effective execution of emergency response tasks.</li> <li>•Correct donning and use of breathing apparatus (BA) (all delegates to practice donning and using BA).</li> <li>•Effective Search and rescue (SAR) principles and techniques –locating, extracting and handling missing personnel and casualties following a helicopter incident on the helideck.</li> <li>•Appropriate response to non-firefighting operations during incident.</li> <li>•Effective use of firefighting fixed, portable and mobile systems, including fixed fire monitors, dry chemical and Co2 fire extinguishment and control media</li> <li>•Correct casualty handling techniques.</li> <li>•Hose-running techniques and associated hazards</li> </ul> <p>Note: All practical exercises require delegates to be fully equipped with firefighting Personal Protective Equipment.</p>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>Delegates will be assessed against the Learning Outcomes specified in the Content Section using direct observation as appropriate.</p> <p>Should a delegate encounter challenges to meet these Learning</p>
