<b>Course name</b>	Advanced Fire Fighting Revalidation (HOUSTM-777)
<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Eligible Maritime Vessel Officers or Installation Workers
<b>Prerequisites</b>	To be eligible to take this course, the delegate must have a minimum of one year of sea service in the last five years.
<b>Objective</b>	Upon completion of this course, the delegate will be able to react in a proper manner to an outbreak of fire, take appropriate measures for the safety of personnel and of the vessel or offshore platform, and correctly use on board firefighting equipment. The delegate will also be able to demonstrate that he/she has both the knowledge and skills stated in the above objective.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>This course is intended to cover the competency elements in STCW Code Table A-VI/3 that were deemed not acceptable to be maintained and demonstrated by onboard training and experience, also 46 CFR 11.303(d). Those elements include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Firefighting at sea and in port</li><li>- Stability in Firefighting</li><li>- Firefighting with dangerous goods</li><li>- The organization of and training of fire parties</li><li>- Detection devices</li><li>- Inspection procedures</li><li>- Incident reports and investigation</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	To successfully complete this course, the delegate must score a minimum of 70% on a 25 question exam as well as 70% on all performance assessments on the fire field.
