Objective	Upon completion of the course, the delegate will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- state the different helicopter designs and construction components,- explain how to rescue passengers safely during a helicopter emergency.- list the procedures to follow in the event of a helicopter fire.- demonstrate how to extinguish different types of helicopter fires.- perform rescues from helicopter simulator with and without smoke.
Contents	The following topics are addressed during the training: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- elements of a fire- fire classifications- extinguisher types and their extinguishing agents- fire hose streams and when to use each type- helicopters used in the Gulf of Mexico- materials used in helicopter construction- PPE needed to respond to a helicopter fire- proper use of an SCBA- firefighting equipment on a helideck- fixed firefighting systems- rescue equipment
Exam	There is no written exam; however, the delegate must be deemed proficient on the practical exercises using the helicopter simulator.
