Aircrew Underwater Escape & Dinghy Drill

Duration	1/2 Day
Target group	The course is designed for aircraft crew and satisfies elements of training to improve safety
Prerequisites	No prior training is required to attend
Objective	The training programme consists of a combination of classroom theory and practical exercises in ditching procedures and aircraft abandonment and basic sea survival
Contents	<p>Escape from a partially submerged aircraft simulator in an upright attitude</p> <p>Escape from a partially submerged aircraft simulator using alternative exits</p> <p>Escape from a partially submerged aircraft simulator in an upright attitude operating emergency exits</p> <p>Escape from a capsized aircraft simulator operating emergency exits</p> <p>The above exercises will be conducted in varying lighting conditions.</p> <p>Appreciation of emergency situations</p> <p>Deployment of life rafts</p> <p>In water survival techniques</p> <p>Re+ righting overturned life rafts</p> <p>Life raft boarding, techniques and safety procedures</p> <p>Rescue from the water by use of a helicopter rescue strop.</p>
