Duration	1/2 Day

Objective	The course consists of a combination of theory and practical exercises in basic emergency procedures. Contents	Delegates will undertake theoretical and practical first aid training in: Principles of First Aid Casualty assessment Recovery Position Resuscitation techniques . Delegates will undertake theoretical and practical fire and smoke training in: Awareness of aircraft incidents Understanding the chemistry of combustion Dealing with fire situations Identification and use of fire extinguishers Working in smoke filled environments
