Those jurisdictions include the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, and the Outer Continental Shelf Lands as defined in the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.</p> <p>Social responsibility refers to the accountability of every person for his or her actions, and how they affect others in the workplace. Being responsible involves following safe work practices and procedures, as well as being professional and respectful to all personnel.</p>
