knowledge of health and safety and should therefore, after suitable site induction, work on site more safely and with lower risk to themselves and

others.

Introduction to Health and Safety Law and Work Permits

Safe Working Practices Safe Access and Egress

Accident and First Aid Procedures Fire Precautions and Procedures

Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) and Personal

Protective Equipment (PPE) Safe Manual Handling

Noise at Work Regulations and The Prevention of Noise Induced Hearing

Safe Working Cranes and Heavy Equipment Safe Working Excavations
