## Permit to Work

<b>Duration</b>	1/2 Day
<b>Target group</b>	A permit to work system is a formal method of ensuring that authorised and properly trained persons have thought about and assessed foreseeable risks and that they can be avoided by using suitable precautions in the workplace.
