Half Day Fire Awareness

Duration	3 hours
Target group	This course is designed for all staff in the industrial, commercial and public sectors, who do not have specific fire training or designated fire responsibilities. To provide general staff with an awareness of the nature of fire and how it may be prevented, and an understanding and practise of the action to be taken in case of fire.
Prerequisites	Not Applicable
Objective	This course consists of a combination of classroom theory utilising audio visual presentation, combined with practical demonstration and participation by delegates.
Contents	The course will focus on: The Nature of Fire - the hazards to life and property / how it starts and spreads. Fire Prevention - the application of safe practice and "good housekeeping" in the workplace / risk awareness. Implementation of the Emergency Plan - discovery of a fire and raising the alarm Understanding the evacuation procedures and escape routes Understanding the use of fire extinguishers and fire control equipment Practical Exercises - selection and use of fire extinguishers
Exam	On completion delegates will have an awareness of the potential causes of fire and how to control the spread of fire, and the ability to locate and operate the correct extinguishing medium. A course certificate will be issued to all delegates completing the training
