Objective The objective this training course is to provide delegates with a basic level

> of fire awareness including prevention and risk minimisation, and in the actions to be taken in the event of a fire or similar emergency on board a

Contents The course covers the following topics;

Fire chemistry and ignition sources

Personal protective equipment

Being prepared for an emergency situation

• The use and safe operation of fire fighting equipment

The role of a fire party member, including the use of breathing apparatus
Shipboard fire fighting organisation

Fire/smoke detection and alarm systems

Exam Training will consist of a mix of theoretical and practical elements and delegates will have to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of

the course contents.

Upon successful completion of the course, delegates will be awarded an MCA-approved Proficiency in Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting certificate. Certification is valid for 5 years at which point delegates should undertake the Updated Proficiency in Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting training

programme to remain certified.
