| Target group | The Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats is for any seafarer who will take charge of a Fast Rescue Craft in an emergency situation and are required to provide evidence of maintaining the necessary standard of competence. |
| Prerequisites | Delegates must be in possession of a Certificate of Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats or equivalent. AND Delegates must also sign a self-declaration form highlighting onboard experience and training. Delegates must bring their Seamans Discharge Book to validate the information on the self-declaration form. |
| Objective | The objective of the Updated Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats course is to give delegates the theoretical and practical knowledge and skills required to maintain the necessary standard of competence in fast rescue boats. |
| Contents | The Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats course covers a variety of topics including; • Routine maintenance procedures and measures for contingency repairs • Pre-use checks • PPE checks for crew and self • Casualty rescue • Capsize procedures |
| Exam | The course is a mix of both practical and theoretical sessions during which delegates will be required to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of the course contents. Upon completion of the course, delegates will be issued with an MCA-approved Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats. Certification is valid for 5 years. Delegates must then undertake the Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats to remain certified. |
