Updated Survival Craft and Rescue Boats Other Than Fast Rescue Boats (Route 1)

Duration	1/2 Day
Target group	The Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats (other than fast rescue boats) is for personnel seeking to refresh under STCW Regulation V1/2 – training or instruction for ratings, able seafarers, trainee officers and others on board for proficiency in survival craft and rescue boats (other than fast rescue boats).
Prerequisites	Delegates must have be in possession of a PSCRB Certificate (from any STCW Country) or AB Certificate (STCW II/4) or UK CEC or UK CoC, and Complete a self-declaration form highlighting training already undertaken onboard a vessel.
Objective	The objective of the Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats course is to ensure delegates maintain the required standard of competence to safely and efficiently launch and operate survival crafts and rescue boats (except fast rescue boats).
Contents	The Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats course covers a variety of topics including: • Operation of a survival craft engine • Operation of survival craft and rescue boat during and after launch • Off-load and on-load release devices • Fall prevention/secondary safety devices • Management of injured persons

Exam

Delegates will be continually assessed against the course contents and requirements of the STCW code. Upon completion of the course, delegates will be issued with a MCA-approved Certificate of Updated Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boasts (other than fast rescue boats) certificate which is valid for 5 years upon which time delegates must again refresh their knowledge.
