Objective	To ensure that personnel responsible for shipping dangerous goods can: •Understand and apply the IMDG Dangerous Goods Regulations •Understand their responsibilities •Classify dangerous goods according to the type of hazard and degree of danger •Identify Proper Shipping Names •Identify dangerous goods which are forbidden for sea transport •Understand and apply the information contained in the Dangerous Goods List •Correctly pack dangerous goods in the appropriate packagings •Mark and label packages •Placard Containers •Document shipments •Accept or reject a shipment based on the above •Appropriately handle and stow dangerous goods
