## Dangerous Goods By Air

<b>Duration</b>	3 days
<b>Target group</b>	Shippers, packers, freight forwarders / cargo agents processing dangerous goods and acceptance staff responsible for dangerous goods shipments.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	None
<b>Objective</b>	<p>To ensure that personnel responsible for shipping dangerous goods can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Understand and apply the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations</li> <li>•Understand their responsibilities</li> <li>•Classify dangerous goods according to the type of hazard and degree of danger</li> <li>•Identify Proper Shipping Names</li> <li>•Identify dangerous goods which are forbidden for air transport</li> <li>•Understand and apply the information contained in the List of Dangerous Goods</li> <li>•Correctly pack dangerous goods in the appropriate packagings</li> <li>•Mark and label packages</li> <li>•Document shipments</li> <li>•Accept or reject a shipment based on the above</li> <li>•Appropriately handle and stow dangerous goods</li> </ul>
