## OIM Controlling Emergencies

<b>Duration</b>	3 Days
<b>Target group</b>	The target group for the OIM Controlling Emergencies Competence Assessment are personnel who have been deemed ready by their employer to be formally assessed in the role of an OIM during an emergency situation.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Candidates require a formal declaration from the candidate's employer confirming that the candidate has achieved the performance criteria in Element 1.1 in the workplace, satisfied the core essential knowledge and asset type knowledge requirements and that the candidate has been deemed ready for formal assessment against Elements 1. 2 to 1.6.
<b>Objective</b>	The aim and objective of the OIM Controlling Emergencies Competence Assessment is to formally assess the candidate in the role of an OIM during an emergency situation in a simulated environment.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The candidate will be assessed against the performance criteria specified in Elements 1.2 to 1.6 under simulated conditions using a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 emergency scenarios based on the type of asset where the candidate is normally required to fulfil the OIM role as agreed and confirmed by the Duty Holder.</p> <p>The candidate must be assessed against all of the following events at least once across the range of incidents, using appropriate combinations for each incident:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Evacuation or abandonment of asset by air and/or sea</li><li>ii. Injured personnel or loss of life</li><li>iii. Missing personnel or man overboard</li><li>iv. Loss of communication</li><li>v. Loss of evacuation and muster points</li><li>vi. Stressed Personnel (individual ineffectiveness or mass panic)</li><li>vii. Extreme weather conditions</li><li>viii. Environmental impact</li><li>ix. Loss of essential facilities</li><li>x. Loss of key personnel</li><li>xi. Rapidly developing situation leading to information overload</li><li>xii. Loss of positioning (where appropriate).</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	OPITO approved certification for OIM Controlling Emergencies will be issued upon successful completion of the assessment.
