## Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System Initial Deployment Training

<b>Duration</b>	1.5 Hours
<b>Target group</b>	Personnel that will be issued with CAEBS whilst travelling by helicopter to offshore installations and vessels and have not undertaken this training in conjunction with their FOET or BOSIET.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Delegates must possess a valid BOSIET, FOET or HUET certificate.
<b>Objective</b>	The objective of this course is to give an initial introduction to the CAEBS equipment and to provide delegates with a practical and theoretical understanding of the safe use of CAEBS in emergency situations.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The CAEBS training covers the following elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The fundamental differences between re-breather and compressed air systems</li><li>• The rationale and use of compressed air emergency breathing systems in helicopter emergency situations</li><li>• The hazards associated with the use of compressed air emergency breathing systems</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>For successful completion of this course, delegates must be able to demonstrate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A pre-flight inspection of the life jacket and CAEBS</li><li>• Donning the life jacket with CAEBS correctly, including 'buddy check'</li><li>• An emergency deployment of the CAEBS in a dry environment</li></ul> <p>Upon completion of the course, delegates will be awarded with an OPITO-approved CAEBS certificate with no expiry date.</p>
