Objective	<p>The training programme is aimed to deliver competence based training of advanced firefighting techniques.</p> <p>Delegates will refresh there basic fire skills and gain knowledge of command and control of fire teams, the organization and training of onboard fire parties and investigation and reporting of fire incidents onboard vessels.</p> <p>Delegates will be assessed by qualified assessors against the competences contained within the STCW Code.</p>

Exam	<p>Delegates will be assessed against the learnings outcomes specified in Section VI/3 of the STCW Code 1978, as amended an the IMO Model Course 2.03 by using direct observation and oral and/or written questions as appropriate.</p> <p>After successful completion of the training AFF, the certification will be valid for 5 years.</p> <p>With the implementation of the Manila Amendments 2010, delegates must provide evidence of having competencies by successfully completing a refresher training every 5 years, as described in the STCW Code 1978, as amended,Section VI-3, Table A-VI/3.</p>
