Those jurisdictions include the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, and the Outer Continental Shelf Lands as defined in the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.</p> <p>In accordance with 29 CFR 1910.1001 & CFR 1926.1101 Over 1 million workers suffer back injuries each year, accounting for 20% of all workplace injuries. Fortunately, workers can easily prevent these injuries by being proactive and practicing safe lifting techniques.</p>
