Contents	<p>The Occupational Safety and Health Administration is an agency of the United States Department of Labour.</p> <p>The OSH Act covers most private sector employers and their workers, in addition to some public sector employers and workers in the 50 states and certain territories and jurisdictions under federal authority. Those jurisdictions include the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, and the Outer Continental Shelf Lands as defined in the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.</p> <p>Stop Work Authority refers to the authority and obligation of all personnel to suspend a work task or operation if they observe an imminent danger that could result in serious injury, damage to property, or loss of life. It is important to learn when and how to exercise Stop Work Authority.</p>
