| Contents | During the course, the emphasis is on systematically understanding the situation of the patient, contact about this with the Radio Medical Service. First aid, general knowledge of disease theory and the matching skills. The emphasis is on illness, nursing and patient care. Performing investigations and medical operations that may be necessary on board. |
| Exam | The certificate is issued on the basis of attendance and the performance of all prescribed actions and / or skills. |
