<b>Course name</b>	Basic Helicopter Fire Fighting (NOGEPA 2.9A)
<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Intended for: Persons designated to act as Helicopter Landing Officer or Helicopter Deck Assistant at a mining installation and is not in the possession of a valid registration in the Personal Safety Logbook (Member Fire-fighting and Rescue team Offshore - 2.6).
<b>Prerequisites</b>	A valid medical certificate + BA.
<b>Objective</b>	<p>This course is intended for everyone who is designated to act as HLO or HDA at a mining installation and is required to act during a helicopter incident as stated in their scope of responsibilities. The objective of this training is to gain knowledge by practical training in helicopter firefighting and rescue actions.</p> <p>Learning targets: Performing fire-fighting and rescue actions in relation to helicopters.</p>
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Practice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Fighting helicopter fires with monitors, fire hoses and portable extinguishers;</li><li>- Rescuing crew and passengers from a burning helicopter.</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>Competence assessment. Validity: 2 years.</p>
