<b>Course name</b>	Basic Coxswain Lifeboat (conventional) (NOGEPa 2.7AC)
<b>Duration</b>	3 days
<b>Target group</b>	Persons who are appointed to the duty as conventional (capsule) lifeboat coxswain on board an offshore installation.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	No training prerequisites are required.  Persons enrolling on this course must be able to show a valid medical certificate prior to participating in practical exercises.
<b>Objective</b>	The objective of the Coxswain Conventional training is to train delegates in the preparation, launching and handling of a rescue craft on board an offshore installation, being a conventional lifeboat. Furthermore to act as the responsible person for a lifeboat and its passengers during normal operation and in the event of an emergency.
<b>Contents</b>	The training will consist of the following learning targets: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Maintaining the lifeboat in an operational condition</li><li>- To contribute to drills or to carry out drills</li><li>- React to alarms</li><li>- Preparation of the lifeboat for launching</li><li>- Boarding allowance</li><li>- Launching the lifeboat</li><li>- Navigation of the lifeboat and moving to a safe area</li><li>- Communication by radio or other means</li><li>- Ensuring safety of passengers and lifeboat</li><li>- Embarking and disembarking of passengers</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	Delegates will be assessed against the learning outcomes specified in the NOGEPa training handbook chapter 2.7 Coxswain lifeboat by using direct observation.
