Prerequisites	<p>No current prerequisites for this course.</p> <p>ITEMS REQUIRED FOR TRAINING:</p> <p>- When checking in for training, please have your GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID with you (ie: Passport or Drivers Licences, etc.)</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: Certificates CANNOT be issued unless valid Government issued ID has been presented on Day 1 of training for all RONC courses, including OPITO approved training.</p>
Objective	<p>Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a RelyOn Nutec Canada certificate that is valid for three (3) years and a electronic wallet card certificate. The certificate indicates: "Workplace NL Fall Protection"</p> <p>Trainee will also be able to access their Workplace NL Fall Protection Certificate from the WorkplaceNL CTR (certification training registry)</p>
Contents	<p>Fall protection is required for workers who work at three (3) metres (10 feet) or more above the nearest safe surface or water, above a surface or thing that could cause injury if the worker were to fall, or above an open pit, tank or vat containing a hazardous substance.</p> <p>Fall protection includes a harness, net, rope, body belt, structure or other equipment and or device that will restrain a worker who is at risk of falling or stop a worker who has fallen. Any worker who uses fall protection is required to complete a fall protection training program prescribed by Workplace NL as outlined in Section 139 of the Newfoundland and Labrador Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, 2009.</p> <p>Training initially must be a minimum of 16 hours in duration and consist of two components: 8 hours of theory and 8 hours of individualized practical training.</p>
