## Confined Space Entry

<b>Duration</b>	1.5hrs online / 4hrs practical
<b>Target group</b>	Offshore
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>1. Record of Completion for the Online Theory (Please bring electronic or hard copy with you for registration).</p> <p>Trainees are expected to be in a good state of health and physically capable of taking part in and completing all practical exercises.</p> <p>ITEMS REQUIRED FOR TRAINING:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- When checking in for training, please have your GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID with you (ie: Passport or Drivers Licences, etc.)</li><li>- Coveralls</li><li>- CSA Approved Footwear (safety boots)</li></ul> <p>PLEASE NOTE: Certificates CANNOT be issued unless valid Government issued ID has been presented on Day 1 of training for all RONC courses.</p>
<b>Objective</b>	Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a RelyOn Nutec Canada certificate that is valid for three (3) years and a electronic wallet card certificate. The certificate indicates: "Confined Space Entry"
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The theoretical (classroom) learning outcomes will be achieved through an online learning management system which is a combination of video modules and a quiz. Upon successful completion of the online portion, the course participant is then eligible to attend on-site training.</p> <p>This course will provide training for confined space supervisors, safety attendants, and entry personnel required to work in a Non-Immediately Dangerous to Life and Health (IDLH) or low hazard confined space.</p> <p>Topics include: review of applicable regulations and codes, program / permit / entry checklist requirements, confined space hazards and control measures, atmospheric monitoring principles, ventilation principals, and non-entry rescue options.</p>
