Contents	<p>The aims and objectives of this course are to ensure those who successfully complete this course achieve the required standard of competence to enable them to contribute to the enhancement of maritime security through heightened awareness and the ability to recognize security threats and to respond appropriately.</p> <p>The following core competencies are to be demonstrated by trainees:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Contribute to the enhancement of maritime security through heightened awareness; 2. Recognition of security threats; and, 3. Understanding the need for and methods of maintaining security awareness and vigilance <p>This one day course is designed to provide the knowledge and security orientation required to enable personnel without designated security duties, working on board Canadian vessels compliant with the Marine Transportation Security Regulations (MSTR Section 214), to enhance ship security and be vigilant of any suspicious activity.</p> <p>This course meets the requirements of Chapter XI-2 of SOLAS 74 as amended, the International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code and Section A-VI/6-1 of the STCW Code applicable to all SOLAS vessels.</p>
