Contents	The Marine Advanced First Aid course includes the use of oxygen, spinal immobilization, and advanced first aid skills, as well as CPR and AED. It is accompanied by a Marine Supplement which includes chapters on marine related topics. This course is approved by Transport Canada and meets the requirements for the Marine Industry.
