Safe Cargo Handling

Objective	LO1: List the regulations and governing bodies that relate to the safe handling of cargo. LO2: Explain the roles and responsibilities of individuals within the cargo supply chain. LO3: Describe the hazards associated with dropped objects, and how to check for them. LO4: Explain how to safely prepare for a lift and how to maintain safety during a lift LO5: Summarise lifting operations categorisation and controls LO6: Explain how to conduct inbound and outbound cargo checks. LO7: Explain best practice when shipping cargo and Dangerous Goods by sea. LO8: Explain best practice when shipping cargo and Dangerous Goods by air. LO9: Summarise the types of issues that lead to non-conforming cargo across the industry LO10: Explain the key principles and best practice when shipping waste.
