Helideck Emergency Response Team Member (HERTM) Further Training

Duration	2 days
Target group	This training programme is targeted at currently-appointed or candidate Offshore Helideck Assistants (HDAs) that require OPITO-certified emergency response training in helideck and helicopter emergencies as part of their overall competence requirement.
Prerequisites	<p>A Valid OPITO Helideck Operations Initial Training Certificate must be held or if you currently hold a HDA Initial or HLO Initial Certificate then these standards will also be accepted.</p> <p>ITEMS TO BRING: All delegates must bring Photographic I.D. or PASSPORT (original or copy)</p> <p>HEALTH: Delegates must be in possession of a valid medical certificate and must complete a medical questionnaire at the beginning of the course.</p>
Objective	The main objectives are for delegates to fully understand the role and responsibilities of a HDA Helideck Emergency Response Team Member and practice responding to a variety of helideck firefighting and non-firefighting emergency scenarios in a training environment.
