## Helideck Emergency Response Team Member (HERTM)

<b>Duration</b>	4 days
<b>Target group</b>	This training programme is targeted at currently-appointed or candidate Offshore Helideck Assistants (HDAs) that require OPITO-certified emergency response training in helideck and helicopter emergencies as part of their overall competence requirement.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>A Valid OPITO Helideck Operations Initial Training Certificate must be held or if you currently hold a HDA Initial or HLO Initial Certificate then these standards will also be accepted.</p> <p>ITEMS TO BRING: All delegates must bring Photographic I.D. and PASSPORT only (original or copy)</p> <p>HEALTH: All delegates will be asked to complete a medical questionnaire prior to course commencement.</p>
<b>Objective</b>	The main objectives are for delegates to fully understand the role and responsibilities of a HDA Helideck Emergency Response Team Member and practice responding to a variety of helideck firefighting and non-firefighting emergency scenarios in a training environment.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The HDA HERTM programme will consist of both Theoretical and Practical Training.</p> <p>Content:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Helideck emergency response pre-planning</li><li>Helideck and helicopter emergency systems and controls</li><li>NUI emergency response requirements</li><li>HDA HERTM response in helideck and helicopter emergencies</li></ul> <p>Delegates will be assessed against the learning outcomes specified in the OPITO Standards</p>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>Delegates will receive an OPITO Approved HDA Helideck Emergency Response Team Member Training certificate once they have been successfully assessed against the learning outcomes within the OPITO Standard.</p> <p>HDA Helideck Emergency Response Team Member Training Certificate expiry is two years.</p> <p>Delegates should report to reception for 08.00hrs, course starts at 08.15hrs, unless otherwise stated.</p>
