Target group This OPITO Approved course is designed for personnel designated as offshore emergency response team leaders on offshore installations.

Prerequisites Delegates attending this programme must possess a valid Offshore Emergency Response Team Member Training (OERTM) certificate

Objective During the course delegates will learn and demonstrate to a level of competence on how to operate fire-fighting and fire protection equipment and how to deal with various fire situations on-board installations. Emphasis will be on leading and controlling fire / emergency response teams.

Exam OPITO approved certification will be issued on successful completion of the training programme. The validity of the OPITO certificate is two years.
