Objective	After ending the course, the delegates must be: - Familiar with the contingency plan and CE / EN marking important - Familiar with the ATS rules for use of personal protective equipment, - The ability to customize personal protective equipment correctly - The ability to climb and move in the heights in a safe and sound manner - The ability to fill the control charts and conduct inspections using the personal protective equipment and rescue equipment, - The ability to perform personal rescue from antenna masts and wind turbines, etc. using rescue equipment
