Control Room Operator Emergency Response

Duration	3 days
Target group	Experienced or new Control Room Operators (CRO) who require Emergency Response Training
Prerequisites	<p>There are no pre-requisites for this course, although an understanding of control room operations is essential</p> <p>Language: All courses are delivered in English, but translators can be arranged accordingly.</p> <p>Health: Prior to attendance at the training centre, delegates are required to complete and sign a medical declaration form in which they declare to be fit enough to participate in all parts of the course. Where a delegate answers YES to any question in Section 1. a doctor's certificate of fitness to participate is required.</p> <p>PPE: Delegates can bring their own PPE if they wish. For waterborne courses swimming trunks are required.</p>
Objective	The aim of the CRO Emergency Response Training course is to introduce delegates to their roles and responsibilities as a CRO, during an emergency in a simulated environment.
Contents	<p>Theory: CRO Roles and Responsibilities during an emergency Intro to Emergency Response Situational Awareness Communications Emergency Procedures and Checklists Stress Management</p> <p>Practical: Introduction to the simulator equipment and software. A number of realistic emergency scenarios covering: 1. Threat to life, 2. Threat to installation, 3. Threat to the environment.</p>
Exam	<p>Delegates will be awarded a RelyOnNutec CRO Emergency Response Training certificate and performance appraisal once they have successfully completed the training program.</p> <p>Validity is 3 years.</p> <p>Delegates should report to reception for 08.00hrs, course starts at 08.15hrs, unless otherwise stated.</p>
