Objective The aim and objectives of the Confined Space - Rescue training

programme is to specifically concentrates on the advanced rescue skills required to provide on-site cover for those working in confined spaces. It assumes previous qualification in entry and SCBA, and covers searching, advanced winching and hauling systems, operations in reduced visibility,

incident management and immediate-response risk assessment (IRRA).
