Advanced Search and Rescue Certificate Course

Duration	5 Days
Target group	This course is aimed at emergency response team members who will be / are involved in search and rescue response to different types of emergency scenarios.
Prerequisites	Delegates attending this training course must have Basic firefighting training.
Objective	This course is designed to provide delegates with the underpinning knowledge on the principles of search and rescue especially from a command and control function and to enable them to participate in realistic scenarios to ensure they are well equipped and prepared to respond to real time emergencies that may occur in the course of their day to day operations.
Contents	This course consists of the following: •Breathing Apparatus Theory •B.A. Control Procedure •Search and Rescue •Casualty Handling and Stretcher •Internal Fire Fighting •Road Transport Collision •Confined Space Rescue •Surface Water Rescue •Collapse Structure Rescue •Rescue from Height •Incident Command System (ICS)
