Confined Space Search and Rescue Training

Duration	2 days
Target group	This course is designed for personnel who are required to enter any confined space to assist or rescue an entrant in distress and also act as part of a Confined Space Rescue Team.
Prerequisites	Participants are expected to have knowledge on safe work systems.
Objective	<p>The aim of this course is to prepare candidates to act as a member of a Confined Space Rescue Team to be able to enter and carry out a rescue as part of a team from within a confined space in an emergency situation.</p> <p>Note: This course will introduce and use SCBA (Self Contained Breathing Apparatus), Airline equipment, Escape Set apparatus and Tripod Sala Winch.</p>
Contents	<p>This course includes the following modules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• An understanding of Confined Space Legislations• Recognition of confined spaces and classification.• Understanding of the hazards associated with confined spaces.• Ability to identify and use specialist equipment required for confined space entry activities.• An understanding of the activity roles and individuals duties regarding confined spaces procedures.• Practical exercises incorporating confined space equipment, emergency scenarios and extrication requirements of casualties.
Exam	On completion of this course, a written assessment will be taken.
