## **Proficiency in Fast Rescue Boats**

Duration	2 Days

This course is aimed at all seagoing personnel designated to launch and **Target group** take charge of a Fast Rescue Boat in emergency situations.

**Prerequisites** All delegates must be in a possession of a valid seafarer medical certificate issued by an approved medical practitioner and show evidence of attending STCW Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats other than

Fast Rescue Boats

**Objective** During the course delegates will gain and demonstrate to a level of

competence on how to handle and take charge such boats during or after launch in adverse weather and sea conditions. The delegates will also be able to operate a Fast Rescue Boat engine, correct use of all locating devices including communication and signalling equipment and how to

carry out search patterns
