Prerequisites	This course is of more benefit to attendees who have worked as part of the Major Emergency Response Team offshore, such as OIM, production and maintenance superintendents, on scene commander, fire team leader, medic, radio operator, control room operator, muster checkers and lifeboat coxswains. Proficiency in written and spoken English is a must.
