Duration	1 day
Target group	Crew members on board ships who need to refresh their competency as FRB crew. (Jet boat)
Prerequisites	Valid basic Certificate of Competency in Fast rescue Boat Valid health certificate
Objective	To refresh the knowledge and skills needed to act as crew on a FRC. The course is acording to STCW 2010, table A-VI/2-2.
Contents	Delegates will undergo practical training in the following subjects
	Construction and outfit of FRBs and individual items of their equipment
	Particular characteristics and facilities of FRBs
	Safety precautions during launch and recovery of an FRB
	Capsizing and procedures for righting a capsized FRB
	How to handle and FRB in prevailing and adverse weather and sea conditions
	Navigational and safety equipment available in an FRB
	Search patterns and environmental factors affecting their execution
	Assessment of the readiness of FRBs and related equipment for immediate use
	Knowledge of the maintenance, emergency repairs, normal inflation and deflation of buoyancy compartments of inflated FRBs
	Methods of starting and operating an FRB engine and its accessories
	Manage injured persons, including the control of bleeding and shock
