Danish Helicopter Landing Officer Course

Duration	2 days
Target group	All personel on an offshore installation in the oil and gas industry, with duties in the internal fire fighting team.
Prerequisites	None
Objective	To provide the participants with basic skills and knowledge of helideck operations during normal traffic and in emergency situations. After the course the participant must be able to: Prepare the helideck before, during and after helicopter handling. Use the current radio procedures and visual hand signals. Perform fuelling of helicopters. Perform quality control of fuel. Fill in the applied papers. Define dangerous goods. Extinguish fire inside and around the helicopter. Participate by rescuing crew and passengers from the helicopter.
