Duration	3 days
Target group	Offshore personnel who shall function as fire fighters on an offshore installation.
Prerequisites	Medical Screening form to be made on arrival at the training center (verified by instructor in the classroom)  Personal ID (verified by instructor in the classroom)
Objective	To give the participants the sufficient skills and knowledge to participate as a member of the fire fighting team on the offshore installation.  The participants shall be able to show ability according to STCW-95, table AIV /1-2.
