## **Offshore Fire Team Leader**

Duration	2 days
Target group	Personnel who shall function as fire leaders on board an offshore installation.
Prerequisites	Valid Offshore Fire Team Member / Offshore Fire Team Member Refresher (The delegate go to the reception for certificate verification)  Medical Screening form to be made on arrival at the training center (verified by instructor in the classroom)  Personal ID (verified by instructor in the classroom)
Objective	To give the participants the sufficient skills and knowledge to provide onsite management in connection with fire fighting onboard offshore installations. At the end of the course the participant shall be able to use the principles for on-site management of available resources of personnel and material and shall be able to plan and exercise fire drills onboard an ofshore installation.
