## Crewmen Helicopter Evacuation and Escape Training

Duration	8 hours
Target group	Offshore workers and professionals.
Prerequisites	- RG and CPF; - Passport (Expatriate); - Occupational Health (ASO) or certificate of good physical and mental Health conditions.
Objective	Instruct and train crew and passengers on safety procedures, escape from a submerged helicopter and sea survival.

- Helicopter underwater escape procedure.
