## Fire Brigade Formation Course - Basic Level - 8h

<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Workers who are in the plan of fire fighting or rescue of the maritime and offshore units, or of industrial spaces.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- RG and CPF;</li><li>- Passport (expatriate);</li><li>- Occupational Health Certificate (ASO) or Certificate of Good Physical and Mental Health Conditions.</li></ul>
<b>Objective</b>	Provide the student with basic knowledge of fire fighting, brigade and first aid that should be applied in emergency situations.
