## CERR - Fast Rescue Boats Course

<b>Duration</b>	32 hours
<b>Target group</b>	Workers who operate Fast Rescue Boats or who might become part of the Fast Rescue Boat support team.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-- Be more than 18 years old;</li><li>- RG and CPF;</li><li>- Passport (expatriate);</li><li>- Occupational health certificate (ASO) or certificate of good physical and health condition;</li><li>- Certificate of Lifeboat course (CESS).</li></ul>
<b>Objective</b>	Qualify the students to perform tasks involving Fast Rescue Boats, according to item 5.6.2.2 of Resolution A-1079 (28) of 04.12.2013, from the International Maritime Organization and Rule VI / 2 of the International STCW Convention and Section A-VI / 2 and Table A-VI / 2-2 of the STCW Code.
