Revalidation (HOUSTM-777) course will satisfy:

The Advanced Firefighting continued standards of competence required by 46 CFR 11.303(b) for mariners who have previously held an Advanced Firefighting endorsement under STCW Code Section A-VI/3, PROVIDED that the mariner has at least 1 year of sea service within the last 5 years; STCW Code Section A-VI/3 and Table A-VI/3, as amended 2010, meeting the National Assessment Guidelines from NVIC 09-14(Ch-1) Tasks 1.3.A, 1.5.A,

2.1.A, 2.1.B, 3.1.A, 3.1.B, 4.1.A, 4.1.B and 4.1.C.

Innhold This course is intended to cover the competency elements in STCW Code

Table A-VI/3 that were deemed not acceptable to be maintained and demonstrated by onboard training and experience, also 46 CFR 11.303(d).

Those elements include:

Firefighting at sea and in portStability in Firefighting

- Firefighting with dangerous goods

- The organization of and training offire parties

Detection devices

- Inspection procedures

- Incident reports and investigation
